Cricket Club News

As summer draws to a close, it's time to reflect back on another cricket season at Worlington.

The club's 1st XI were unable to replicate their success of a top four spot which they achieved last year, but were able to do enough to secure Division One status for another season finishing in tenth place. Graham Ford, with 714 runs, was the team's top run-scorer with Jimmy Watson (599) just missing out on the 600 run mark for the year. On the bowling front, it was the club's overseas player Cody Golding, with 34 wickets, that topped the bowling chart. We wish Cody all the best for his future endeavours and a safe return journey back to his native New Zealand.

The 2nd XI, now under the captaincy of Jonno Peachey, put the disappointment of last season's relegation behind them, as they secured promotion back to Division Five finishing second in the league behind champions Stowupland. Matthew Peachey (427 runs) was the best of the batsmen while Paul Marston (29 wickets) was again the pick of the bowlers.

The Academy, continued to put in some pleasing performances throughout the summer in a higher league after their promotion to Division Three of the Sunday Competition. The Academy squad featured a total of twelve players under the age of 18, alongside some more experienced heads to help them continue to develop their game. It was 17 year old Matthew Wittish that was the pick of the players, finishing top run-scorer and top wicket taker with 487 runs and 28 wickets respectively.

As always, the club's junior sides were extremely busy throughout the summer with the U11s securing the Suffolk County Cup defeating Easton in the final. Congratulations to team coach Colin Thompson and the playing squad. A special mention goes to the club's very own Arthur Summers who picked up the award for the U11 Suffolk Boys Player of the Season - well done Arthur!



Finally, on behalf of Worlington Cricket Club, we wish to thank everyone that helped support the club in one form or another throughout the summer. Work will continue to go on behind the scenes throughout the winter months in preparation for 2018."

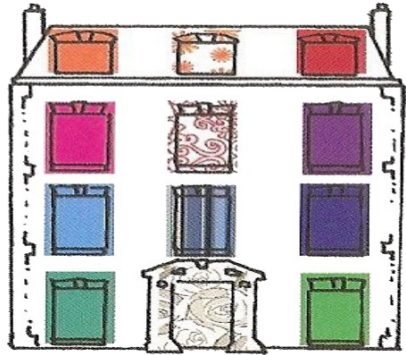

Dear Friends,

As the weather becomes more autumnal and nights begin to draw in, I'm reminded that in a few weeks it will be my birthday. All through my childhood falling leaves and misty mornings gave me that unmistakable feeling of excitement. Soon there would be presents, and joy of joys, a party with my friends from school. I used to look forward to the party so much, because it fell near enough to November for my dad to be able to buy fireworks. He would build an enormous bonfire, we would drink hot chocolate and eat potatoes that had been baked in foil in the embers, and 'ooh!' and 'aaah!' at the roman candles, silver fountains and Catherine wheels. I have never forgotten the colourful sparks and lovely gunpowder smells. However, it all came to an end when my dad heard about some children who had been injured by fireworks, and my bonfire birthday parties were no more. Sad for me, but looking back I'm glad he cared so much about our safety.

Nowadays, perhaps because of the firework injuries, the major autumn fun for children seems to revolve around Hallowe'en, a seemingly safer option (though I have personally sustained injuries when trying to carve 'Jesus is the Light of the World' into a large pumpkin). Dressing up and doing craft activities is always fun, but I have to admit I'm not a fan of filling children's minds with thoughts of scary things, or of encouraging them to take sweets from strangers for that matter. I get the argument that dressing up as ghouls or monsters helps them to work through their imaginary fears, but it seems to encourage thoughts of normal things being scary too. For instance I saw in one supermarket, amongst the Hallowe'en costumes and masks, signs saying 'To the Graveyard' in 'spooky' writing. Our church is of course set in a graveyard, and people often comment to me how peaceful and beautiful it is. When it holds our loved ones it becomes not only beautiful but sacred. Why would we want to encourage the idea that it is scary?

So as Autumn begins to draw in do enjoy whatever celebrations you have, but I hope that they are full of light and life rather than dark spookiness – and that all in our community will stay safe, with or without fireworks!
