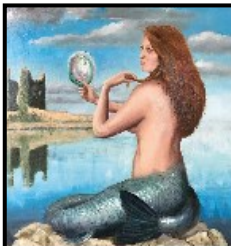

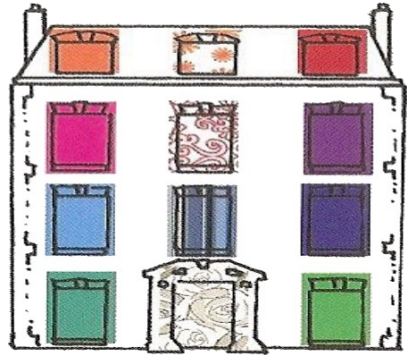

Bird Talk

Church Swifts

Although our swifts returned on time on 6th May they were slow to build up numbers. You may have seen reports in the press saying that this was a widespread problem caused by unspecified weather conditions in or near Spain. Apparently the skies above Barcelona were black with swifts.

On 17th June our ever dependable and hard working ringer (of birds not bells), Simon Evans, went up the tower to check the swift boxes. The news was good - 34 of our 42 nest boxes were occupied, which is 2 more than last year. However Simon didn't think there would be as many chicks as the amazing 68 he ringed last year.

Happily this glitch seems to have been a delay rather than a disaster for us but in other parts of the country it is not so good. A friend in the West Country tells me that he has seen hardly any this year compared to their usual numbers.

Simon said that expert observers are concerned about general low breeding indications this year, especially among raptors, and are unsure as to the possible causes.

Churchyard Barn Owls

The industrious Simon Evans, who also heads up the Suffolk Barn Owl Project, intended to check our owl box when he was here on the 17th. However, as other boxes he has checked are behind schedule in producing chicks he thought it would be better to leave it for a couple of weeks. We just hope that there are owls & chicks there to be checked.

A hopeful sign is that there have been many reports of barn owls hunting near the Hythe and the Staunch. The excellent picture of the owl in was, again, taken by Pat Gates - thank you Pat. Pat says it looked as if it was heading towards the churchyard and I just hope that it was.



Our Back Garden

There has been no lack of breeding in our back garden and adjoining areas; the place is bursting with young birds. For over 4 weeks until mid June we have had multiple daily visits from an adult, usually male, great spotted woodpecker which has been great. Then one day recently a youngster turned up, resplendent with its scarlet crown, and attacked the nuts with gusto. In the past the young 'peckers had always been accompanied by an adult for their first few visits, but not this year; better still a couple of days later two young birds arrived simultaneously and

squabbled for supremacy on the feeder. As June moves on we are still getting entertaining daily visits from our 'peckers, both young and mature.

We have never had so many baby blue tits than this year and they are quite delightful. They are tiny and look so innocent and vulnerable in their still pale colours. They cluster on the feeders in groups of up to six and don't fly away when I approach to top up the nuts and the bird seed - I have got to about a couple of feet from the feeder before they scatter. I hope they learn their essential small bird survival skills before a predator gets them.

The Village

In mid June Chris and Michel Hall saw an oyster catcher in their paddock. About the same time a friend of a friend reported seeing one on the cricket field. I have seen some along Green Lane in the horse meadow on the right (coming from Golf Links Road) just before the farm track "crossroads." They cluster there when heavy rain has created temporary small ponds. I just love the way their orange bills contrast with their black and white plumage and in flight, especially in large numbers, they are stunning.
